

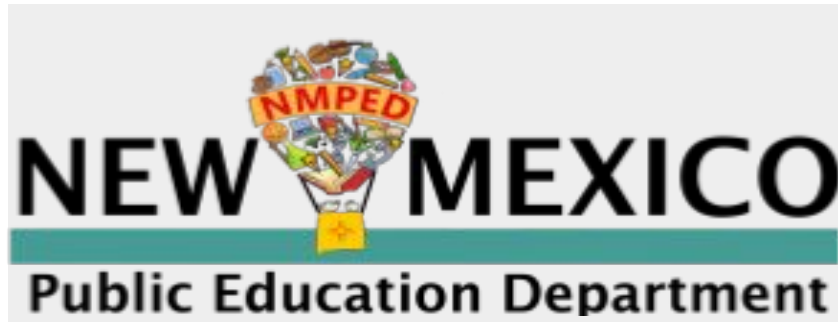


NMEAF Financial Aid Education

New Mexico Public Education Department (NMPED) and New Mexico Educational Assistance Foundation (NMEAF) have developed the Student Financial Aid Education Course. This course is designed to provide students with general knowledge of the financial aid process at federal and state levels. To access this course teachers and/or counselors should follow the steps below.

My school doesn't have Canvas

The course will be placed in **NMPED Canvas Commons** again this year. NMPED will make the Canvas **export available to districts** that don't use Canvas



I have Canvas but not Commons

1. Email Canvas.admin@state.nm.us to request the course be cartridges to you.
2. You will need to open the zip file to see the content and import into the LMS you are currently using.

You can not place students in a Canvas course in a non-implemented LEA.

If you are an implemented LEA but do not have access to Commons

a. Reach out to Canvas.admin@state.nm.us

- i. The LMS team can provide you with the needed access to Commons so you can access the course and roster students.
- ii. The LMS team can cartridge the course to your LEA so that you can access the course and roster students.

If personnel do not have a Canvas Account

(first-time Canvas user)

- a. If you have **NEVER** had a Canvas account in New Mexico, please email Canvas.admin@state.nm.us to request one.

There will be a **public link** that has the information - if LEA's do not use Canvas or choose not to import in their own instance. No quizzes - just a webpage.
