IT'S THE LAW

New Mexico Senate Bill 582 (2005)

- A. A public post-secondary educational institution shall not deny admission to a student on account of the student's immigration status.
- B. Any tuition rate or state-funded financial aid that is granted to residents of New Mexico shall also be granted on the same terms to all persons, regardless of immigration status.

Qualifying Criteria for State Aid

- A. Attended a secondary educational institution in New Mexico for at least one year,

AND

- B. Have either graduated from a New Mexico high school *or* received a general educational development certificate in New Mexico.
