






What is Financial Aid

Money to help you pay for college, provided through the federal government, state, school, or a private business or organization.











What is State Aid






How do I qualify for the Lottery Scholarship?

To qualify for the Lottery Scholarship, you will need to:

- •Enroll full-time at a New Mexico public college or university within 16 months of high school graduation or completion of a high school equivalency or home school certificate. Fulltime means:
 - 15 credit hours at a four-year university
 - 12 credit hours at a community college
- •Achieve and maintain a 2.5 grade point average (GPA).
- ·Maintain full-time enrollment every fall and spring semesters.











What is a FSA ID?

Create your Account (FSA ID)

The **Federal Student Aid** (FSA) **ID** is a **username** and **password** that is required to log in and access all Federal Student Aid websites, including the **FAFSA**.

Whether you're a student, parent, or borrower, you'll need to create your own account to manage the student loan journey.











Contributor Information – Invite










Financial aid award offers outline the details of the financial aid package you are being offered.
